Everything comes with an instruction manual. Even kids! The instruction manual is the Bible. Remember two chapters in the Bible on parenting: Deuteronomy 6 and Ephesians 6.

I) Deuteronomy 6:1-12

Deuteronomy means, “ Repetition of the Law’s of God.”

Literally: to repeat God’s laws.

A) Deuteronomy 6:1-2—“To teach you”

You parents are to learn God’s Word so that they can teach the kid’s who will teach their kids (v.2).

It starts with the parents and God’s Word.

B) Deuteronomy 6:4-6

Verse 6—These commands are to be upon your hearts. This is an on going process - not waiting until we parents know it all; but as we learn, we teach whatever we have learned to our kids.

C) Deuteronomy 6:4 & 7-9—Teach

Verse 4—That the Lord is ONE - the ONLY God.

Verse 7—Impress them (God’s Word) on your children.

Impress = To fix deeply in the mind

Them = The 10 Commandments

Verses 7-9—When and where to teach?

When you sit down, walk, lie down, get up.

The main idea here is to use short lessons.

Verse 8—Memorize scripture.

Verse 9—Cue cards

Verses 10-12—Use the holidays

Verses 20-25—Questions and answers

The objective in all this is verse 25, “that will be our righteousness.”

Ours = You, your kids, your grandkids

II) Ephesians 6:1-4

A) Verse 4—must take place or verses 1-3 will not.

Dads, if you are not bringing up your children in the training and instruction of the Lord (if not) then verses 1-3: there will not be any obedience or honoring of you parents.

Training = Discipline

Instruction = Teaching

Exasperated = Expected to do something they do not know how to do.

But when verse 4 happens, verse 3 is the outcome: “that it may go well with you (parents & kids) and that you (parents & kids) may enjoy long life on earth.”

Remember Deuteronomy 6 and Ephesians 6: God’s parenting manual.

“If all else fails, read the instructions.”

“Read the instructions before all else fails.”

The boxes are provided, and items must be able to fit in them.**

Gifts for boys and girls in the following age groups: 2-4 year olds 5-9 year olds 10-14 year olds

Give one nice "WOW" item such as a doll, stuffed animal, toy truck or boat, small musical instrument, backpack, soccer ball (w/air pump).

Other gifts could include note cards & stationery, school supplies, solar calculator, toothbrush, compact mirror, comb & brush, reusable plastic containers, socks, underwear, clothes, flip-flops, hat/cap, blanket, flashlight, compass, binoculars, magnets, fishing kit, wrist watch, sunglasses, picture books and puzzles, coloring books & crayons, foam ball, yo-yo, small Frisbee, skipping rope, bead jewelry or kit, hair accessories or kit, kaleidoscope, tennis ball, hacky-sack, Matchbox cars.

Please do not send any of the following: toothpaste, medications, vitamins, gum, candy, or food of any kind; war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; or liquids, lotions, or breakable items such as snow globes, glass containers, or aerosol cans.

Please do send money to be used toward postage. "You bring the items, and we will fill the boxes."

You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself, family, or group. If you include your name and address, the child may be able to write back to you.
